



# State Environment Activity Camp 2018

Camp Coutts

12<sup>th</sup> to 14<sup>th</sup> October 2018

## Information for Applicants

Cubs, Scouts and Venturers from across NSW are invited to participate in the 2018 State Environment Activity Camp (SEAC) at Camp Coutts at Waterfall in Southern Sydney. Over the weekend Scouts will participate in a whole range of activities aimed at increasing their awareness and appreciation for the natural environment.

- Cubs and Scouts participating in the camp will complete parts of the World Scout Environment Badge
- Venturers have the opportunity to complete their Venture Level Environment Tape at the camp. The submission of the report component will be completed post camp.

Groups will be camping in tents (not supplied by SEAC) at Coutts, all food will be provided and cooked by the SEAC caterers.

Groups must send the appropriate number of leaders/ adults with their Cubs or Scouts for the application to be accepted.

### How to Apply

Applications for SEAC must be completed and 'submitted' online. There are limited places so make sure you get your applications in early to avoid disappointment. Applications will close at midnight on the 31<sup>st</sup> August 2018.

When you have 'submitted' your application, you then need to print it and:

- Under 18 year old (Cubs, Scouts & Venturers): ensure that both parents and/or guardians (where applicable) sign the Agreement, Activities and Authority form and tick the appropriate 4 boxes for Activities, Authority and Court Order.
- Leaders, Rover & Adult Helpers: ensure that the Agreement, Activities and Authority form is signed by yourself.

Then all applicants need to obtain the required signatures as follows:

Cubs, Scouts & Venturers

Your Section leader is required to sign your application form

Leaders, Rover and Adult Helpers

Your Group Leader is required to sign your application form

After ensuring you have the required signatures you will need to send your signed application sheet to [SEAC.nsw@gmail.com](mailto:SEAC.nsw@gmail.com) and bring your signed application sheet with you to SEAC.

You will be advised in early September if your application has been successful. At this time, you will be required to log back into your online application to pay the camp fee. We will also provide further information on the camp.

## Eligibility

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### Cubs

- Must be a registered member of Scouts Australia NSW at the time of application and through till the 14<sup>th</sup> October 2018.
- Have approval from their Cub Leader
- Have consent from their parents/ guardian
- Cubs must be accompanied by their Cub leader

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### Scouts

- Must be a registered member of Scouts Australia NSW at the time of application and through till the 14<sup>th</sup> October 2018.
- Have approval from their Scout Leader
- Have consent from their parents/ guardian
- Scouts must be accompanied by their Scout leader

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### Venturers

- Must be a registered member of Scouts Australia NSW at the time of application and through till the 14<sup>th</sup> October 2018.
- Have approval from their Venturer Leader
- Have consent from their parents/ guardian

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### Leader/ Rover

- Must be registered as a Rover member of Scouts Australia NSW or hold an Adult Appointment in Scouts Australia NSW at the time of application and through till 14<sup>th</sup> October 2018
- Be recommended by their Crew Leader or Group Leader

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### Adult Helper

- Must be a registered member of Scouts Australia NSW at the time of application and through till 14<sup>th</sup> October 2018
- Be recommended by their Group Leader

## Cost

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Cost is for all attendees including Cubs, Scouts, Venturers, Leader and Adult Helpers.

Early Bird Price (Application submitted on or before 3 <sup>rd</sup> August)	\$65
Standard Price (Application submitted after 3 <sup>rd</sup> August)	\$70

Cost includes camping fees, activities, presenters and all food.  
You must provide your own tents and personal gear.

## Payments

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All payments are to be made through the online application system \*. Once you have been accepted you will have 7 days to make this payment, otherwise your place will be offered to another Cub, Scout or Venturer.

\*Credit card fees may be applicable

## **Withdrawals**

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If after making an application, you are unable to attend SEAC, you must email [SEAC.nsw@gmail.com](mailto:SEAC.nsw@gmail.com) as soon as possible.

Withdrawal fees will apply as follows:

Written Notification of withdrawal received by	Withdrawal Fee
- Before 7 <sup>th</sup> September 2018	Full refund
- On or before 10 <sup>th</sup> September 2018	\$35
- After 10 <sup>th</sup> September 2018	No refund

SEAC reserves the right to refuse any application, in which case a full refund will be made.
